

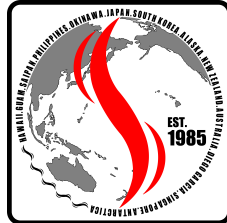

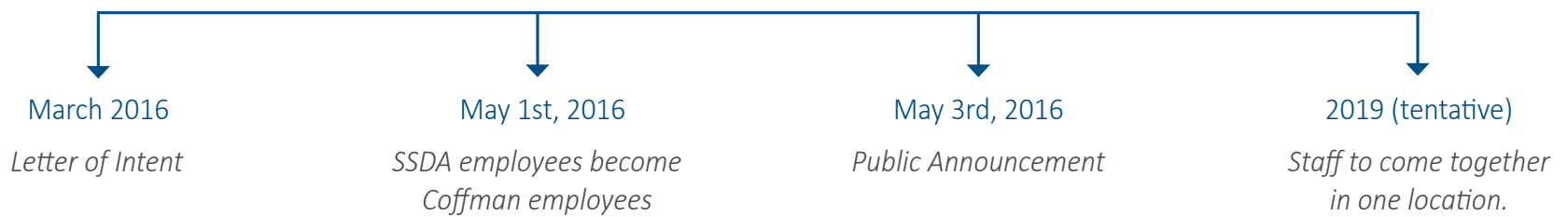


Office Space
