 - Ambassadors (25 individuals) As notable leaders in the tech industry, Ambassadors act as spokespeople and thought leaders for the community. The Ambassadors of Techweek100 are an inspiring and diverse group founders, influencers and other prominent voices acting as positive voices of change. Ambassadors include Navdeep Baines (Minister of Innovation,



Science, and Economic Development of Canada), Ilse Treurnicht (CEO of MaRS), and Iain Klugman (CEO of Communitech).
